



Pavilions May be Enclosed by Tent Walls – by Doug Smith

The pavilions at Lake Erie Shores will have the capability of being enclosed by residents who want to avoid nasty or blustery lakefront weather. A series of tent sides can be leased and hung from the eaves of the pavilions, totally or partially enclosing a pavilion - for just over \$200.

The beach pavilion wiring and hardware project is now complete, so that pavilion can handle tent-walls. The playground pavilion will be similarly equipped later this summer.

The tent walls - or tent sides - can be leased from area renters. Advanced Tent Solutions of Newbury will provide two different types of tent wall for a June 16 wedding at the beach pavilion. Part of the pavilion will have opaque, white side walls, and the portions of the pavilion facing the lake will use clear side walls. Both styles of tent wall clip to a 160-foot wire that surrounds of the exterior of the pavilion.

The sections are 20 feet in length, so two sections are needed to cover each side of the 40 X 40 foot beach pavilion. Opaque 20-foot sections can be rented for \$20 each; clear sections are \$30 each. The total is \$210, plus tax, of course, to enclose the pavilion with a mix of opaque

and clear sections. (The photo shows examples of both clear and white opaque.)



According to Advanced Tent Solutions, the tent sides are most valuable in defense of high winds and blowing rain. If weather is good - no wind and rain - the sides easily can be pulled open. In extreme cold, the sides will hold enough heat inside a pavilion to keep it comfortable.
