



Recycling Option at Buckeye Industries

Buckeye Industries has 4 locations in northeast Ohio and they use the items dropped off for recycling to fund their programs. The mission statement from their web site is as follows:

The mission of New Avenues to Independence is to provide opportunities for people with disabilities to become more independent and productive members of society by offering the highest quality support services and developing innovative and inclusive programs.



Items recycled are aluminum, tin, cardboard and Styrofoam. Debbie White (Madison location) stated that items can be dropped off at any time in a

covered area and placed in bins.

Another service that they provide is document shredding, but this is not free. The charge is 0.12 \$/lb for this service and they are certified, HIPPA compliant, etc. Documents for shredding can be dropped off Mon-Fri from 9 AM to 3 PM. However, if you call Debbie [440-428-0042], she stated that arrangements can be made for drop-offs outside of those hours. The two closest locations are as follows:
